RESOLUTION:

A) CONSOLIDATING THE STATEWIDE DIRECT PRIMARY ELECTION TO BE HELD ON TUESDAY, JUNE 2, 2026, WITH ELECTIONS CALLED BY BRISBANE SCHOOL DISTRICT, RAVENSWOOD CITY SCHOOL DISTRICT, AND REDWOOD CITY ELEMENTARY SCHOOL DISTRICT; AND

B) AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY'S CHIEF ELECTIONS OFFICER TO PROVIDE SPECIFIED ELECTION SERVICES AND SUPPLIES IN CONJUNCTION THEREWITH

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, Election Code Sections 10400 through 10418 authorize the Board to order the consolidation of elections that are called to be held on the same day in or within the same territory upon the order of the governing body or bodies calling the elections and, if ordered, the consolidated election shall be held in all respects as if it were one election, with the returns being canvassed by the County's Chief Elections Officer; and

WHEREAS, absent other arrangements or applicable law, the costs of any school district election shall be borne by the school district holding the election pursuant to Education Code Section 5421, and any district shall reimburse the County in full for the services performed by the County's Chief Elections Officer in accordance with Division 10 of the Elections Code; and

WHEREAS, the governing board of the Brisbane School District adopted Resolution No. 2025-2026-V giving notice of an election to be held on June 2, 2026 for the purpose of submitting a parcel tax measure to voters in its jurisdiction, and requesting

the County's Chief Elections Officer to render specified election services to the District therefor; and

WHEREAS, the governing board of the Ravenswood City School District adopted Resolution No. 26-20 giving notice of an election to be held on June 2, 2026 for the purpose of submitting a bond measure to voters in its jurisdiction, and requesting the County's Chief Elections Officer to render specified election services to the District therefor; and

WHEREAS, the governing board of the Redwood City Elementary School District adopted Resolution No. 21 giving notice of an election to be held on June 2, 2026 for the purpose of submitting a parcel tax measure to voters in its jurisdiction, and requesting the County's Chief Elections Officer to render specified election services to the District therefor; and

WHEREAS, each of the aforementioned local school district governing boards has requested that its respective election, as described in the above findings, be consolidated with the June 2, 2026 Statewide Direct Primary Election ("June 2026 Primary Election"); and

WHEREAS, the County's Chief Elections Officer is agreeable to providing specified election services and supplies requested and enumerated in the above findings in conjunction with the June 2026 Primary Election; and

WHEREAS, in consideration of the services and supplies to be provided by the County's Chief Elections Officer in conducting the elections described in the above findings, each local governing body requesting such services and supplies will, as

required by law, enter into separate agreements with the County's Chief Elections Officer to outline the services to be rendered and to reimburse the County for the costs of said services and supplies.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the June 2026 Primary Election is hereby consolidated with the local elections described in this Resolution duly called by their respective governing bodies, and the County's Chief Elections Officer is authorized to provide specified election services and supplies in conjunction therewith.
