**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH CASA CIRCULO CULTURAL TO PROVIDE YOUTH, ADULT, AND CORRECTIONAL SERVICES PROGRAMS, FOR THE TERM OF JULY 1, 2025 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2027, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$316,380**

**RESOLVED**, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

**WHEREAS**, in June 2025, the Sheriff’s Office completed a Request for Proposals (RFP) for youth, adult, and correctional services programs; and

**WHEREAS**, Casa Circulo Cultural was selected based on its strong and consistent track record of delivering high-quality, culturally relevant programming across the North Fair Oaks and South County areas; and

**WHEREAS**, the programming demonstrates commitment to art, culture, and education as pathways to community connection and empowerment, contributing to a safer and more inclusive San Mateo County.

**WHEREAS**, the Sheriff’s Office desires to enter into an agreement with Casa Circulo Cultural to provide youth, adult, and correctional services programs for the term of July 1, 2025 through June 30, 2027, in an amount not to exceed \$316,380; and

**WHEREAS**, this Board has been presented with a form of such agreement, has examined and approved it as to both form and content, and desires to enter into it.

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED** that the Board of Supervisors be and is hereby authorized and directed to execute said agreement for and on behalf of the County of San Mateo, and the Clerk of the Board shall attest the President's signature thereto.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Sheriff or Sheriff's designee is authorized to execute contract amendments which modify the County's maximum fiscal obligation by no more than \$25,000 (in aggregate) and/or modify the contract term and/or services so long as the modified term or services is/are within the current or revised fiscal provisions.
