RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DISTRICT ATTORNEY TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE CALIFORNIA VICTIM COMPENSATION BOARD FROM FISCAL YEAR 2023-24 THROUGH FISCAL YEAR 2025-26 FOR THE PURPOSE OF FUNDING A RESTITUTION SPECIALIST POSITION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$242,862

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, the San Mateo County District Attorney’s Office has previously entered into an agreement with the California Victim Compensation Board (hereafter referred to as the “CalVCB”) and desires to continue the program to ensure the imposition of restitution orders to the CalVCB and restitution fines on all convicted offenders in accordance with applicable statutes; and

WHEREAS, the CalVCB has authorized and allocated \$242,862 for the period of July 1, 2023 through June 30, 2026 to implement this project subject to a Standard Agreement and acknowledgement of the terms and conditions contained therein, executed by the District Attorney;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the District Attorney of the County of San Mateo is authorized to enter into an agreement with the California Victim Compensation Board and any extensions or amendments thereof which do not require commitment of County funds from FY 2023-24 and FY 2025-26 for the purpose of funding a Restitution Specialist position in the amount of \$242,862.
