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RESOLUTION ACCEPTING DONATIONS TOTALING \$100,620 AND A GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$62,000 IN SUPPORT OF ARTS AND CULTURE IN SAN MATEO COUNTY

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that:

WHEREAS, on June 1, 2021, the County Executive initiated the Office of Arts and Culture ("OAC") for the purpose of strengthening the organizational structure of the San Mateo County Arts Commission ("Arts Commission"), and, on August 2, 2022, the Board formally established the OAC; and

WHEREAS, the mission of the Arts Commission is to elevate the significance of arts and culture as a key driver in enhancing the quality and vibrancy of life, education, and economy in San Mateo County through coordination of art and culture-related policies and programs, which mission is furthered through funding in the form of donations and grants; and

WHEREAS, the County has received the following donations totaling \$100,620 in furtherance of the Arts Commission's mission:

WHEREAS, the OAC has received a grant in the amount \$62,000 from the California Arts Council to fund arts and culture in San Mateo County; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to County Administrative Memorandum B-3, "[r]eceipt of each gift or bequest having a value of more than \$2,500 or with significant conditions or stipulations shall be acknowledged in writing by the [County] department head and referred to the Board of Supervisors for acceptance or rejection[,]" and this Board desires to accept the above-described donations totaling \$100,620, as well as the \$62,000 grant from the California Arts Council; and

WHEREAS, concurrent with this resolution, the Board will be approving an Appropriation Transfer Request in the total amount of \$162,620, recognizing unanticipated revenue from the above-described donations totaling \$100,620 and the \$62,000 grant from the California Arts Council, and transferring such amount to the OAC.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that, pursuant to County Administrative Memorandum B-3, the Board accepts the donations described in this resolution totaling \$100,620 and the \$62,000 grant from the California Arts Council.

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
