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**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT WITH
EQUITABLE SOCIAL SOLUTIONS TO PROVIDE HOUSING AND DISABILITY
ADVOCACY PROGRAM (HDAP) HOMELESSNESS PREVENTION ASSISTANCE
SERVICES TO ADD \$163,975 IN FUNDS FOR A REVISED TOTAL AMOUNT NOT
TO EXCEED \$388,975, AND TO EXTEND THE TERM BY ONE YEAR FOR A
REVISED TERM OF JULY 1, 2025 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2027**

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, May 23, 2024, the Human Services Agency (HSA) issued a Request for Proposals (RFP) for Housing and Disability Advocacy Program (HDAP) Homelessness Prevention Assistance and all applications received were evaluated; and

WHEREAS, On June 24, 2025, by Resolution No. 081320, this Board authorized the County of San Mateo to execute an Agreement with Equitable Social Solutions for HDAP Homelessness Prevention Assistance Services as a pilot for shallow subsidy rental assistance in San Mateo County for households at risk of homelessness for an amount not to exceed \$225,000 and a term of July 1, 2025, through June 30, 2026; and

WHEREAS, in November 2025, the California Department of Social Services (CDSS) announced HDAP funding for FY 2025-26 with an expenditure deadline of June 30, 2028; and

WHEREAS, In December 2025, the HSA accepted \$416,001 in non-competitive awards from CDSS for HDAP expenditures through June 30, 2028; and

WHEREAS, under this proposed amendment, Equitable Social Solutions will continue to provide HDAP Homelessness Prevention Assistance services for families and adults at risk of experiencing homelessness; and

WHEREAS HSA is requesting to amend the Agreement with Equitable Social Solutions to increase funding by \$163,975 for a revised total amount not to exceed \$388,975 and extend the contract term for this pilot program for one year through June 30, 2027.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the President of this Board of Supervisors be and is hereby authorized and directed to execute said amendment for and on behalf of the County of San Mateo, and the Clerk of the board shall attest the President's signature thereto.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of the Human Services Agency or designee is authorized to execute contract amendments which modify the County's maximum fiscal obligation by no more than \$25,000 (in aggregate), and/or modify the contract term and/or services so long as the modified term or services is/are within the current or revised fiscal provisions.

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
