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**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT WITH
MAURER DERMATOLOGY ASSOICATES TO PROVIDE DERMATOLOGY
SERVICES, EXTENDING THE TERM BY FOUR MONTHS THROUGH MARCH 31,
2026, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$1,829,000**

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, the County of San Mateo entered into an agreement with Maurer Dermatology Associates whereby Dr. Toby Maurer and her associates will provide professional medical dermatology services, including teledermatology screenings, dermatology clinic and on-call coverage services, at San Mateo Medical Center for the term of December 1, 2022, through November 30, 2025, in an amount not to exceed \$1,629,000; and

WHEREAS, the parties anticipate that Maurer Dermatology Associates may cease providing dermatology services once a new “e-consult” platform goes live; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to amend Maurer Dermatology Associates’ contract to add a four-month extension for an extended term of December 1, 2022, through March 31, 2026, and add \$200,000 to the “not to exceed” amount, in an amount not to exceed \$1,829,000 to bridge dermatology coverage until the new “e-consult” platform is implemented; and

WHEREAS, this Board has been presented with a form of such agreement, has examined and approved it as both form and content, and desires to enter into it.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the President of the Board of Supervisors be and is hereby authorized and directed to execute said amendment to the agreement for and on behalf of the County of San Mateo, and the Clerk of the Board shall attest the President's signature thereto.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chief of San Mateo County Health or designee is authorized to execute contract amendments which modify the County's maximum fiscal obligation by no more than \$25,000 (in aggregate) and/or modify the contract term and/or services so long as the modified term or services is/are within the current or revised fiscal provisions.

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
