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RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT NO. 43000-26-D009 WITH DATA VISION GROUP, LLC TO EXPAND THE SCOPE OF WORK TO INCLUDE THE DEVELOPMENT AND IMPLEMENTATION OF A SITUATIONAL AWARENESS INFORMATION EXCHANGE COMMUNITY-BASED ORGANIZATION (CBO) COMMUNICATION PLATFORM, EXTENDING THE TERM BY FOUR (4) MONTHS THROUGH MAY 19, 2029, AND INCREASING THE NOT-TO-EXCEED AMOUNT BY \$151,000 FOR A REVISED TOTAL NOT-TO-EXCEED AMOUNT OF \$336,000

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, pursuant to Government Code Section 31000, the County may contract with independent contractors for the furnishing of such services to or for the County or any Department thereof; and

WHEREAS, on January 7, 2026, the County entered into Agreement No. 43000-26-D009 with Data Vision Group, LLC for the design of a Geospatial Situational Awareness Exchange Dashboard for the Department of Emergency Management (the "Agreement"), which became effective January 7, 2026, and would otherwise expire on January 6, 2029; and

WHEREAS, the parties now desire to amend the Agreement to expand the scope of work to include the development and implementation of a Situational Awareness Information Exchange Community-Based Organization (CBO) Communication Platform, to extend the term of the Agreement by three (3) months through April 6, 2029, and to

increase the not-to-exceed amount by \$151,000 for a revised total Agreement amount not to exceed \$336,000; and

WHEREAS, there has been presented to this Board of Supervisors for its consideration and acceptance an Amendment to Agreement No. 43000-26-D009 with Data Vision Group, LLC, together with revised Exhibit A (Scope of Services) and revised Exhibit B (Payments and Rates), reference to which is hereby made for further particulars; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Emergency Management has determined that the Amendment is in the best interests of the County and will enhance coordination, communication, and situational awareness between the County and operational community partners during both steady-state and emergency operations.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the Board of Supervisors be and is hereby authorized to execute said amendment for and on behalf of the County of San Mateo, and the Clerk of this Board shall attest the President's signature thereto.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director or designee is authorized to execute amendments to the agreement which modify the County's maximum fiscal obligation by no more than \$25,000 (in aggregate), and/or modify the contract term and/or services so long as the modified term or services is/are within the current or revised fiscal provisions.

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
