RESOLUTION DESIGNATING OCTOBER 19-25, 2025

*United Against Hate Week*  
*San Mateo County Stands Stronger Together*

**WHEREAS**, San Mateo County is home to a diverse multitude of communities, cultures, and identities; and

**WHEREAS**, the **County of San Mateo** is committed to uplifting shared humanity, and promoting collaboration among residents of all backgrounds; and

**WHEREAS**, the **County of San Mateo** stands steadfastly against efforts to undermine or harm any individual, family, or community based on their identify; and

**WHEREAS**, in 2024 nearly 1,200 acts of hate were reported in California, and in more than two-thirds of the cases, residents asked about receiving counseling, legal help, or other care resources; and

**WHEREAS**, the **County of San Mateo** affirms the dignity of each individual who calls our County home, regardless of race, ethnicity, national origin, ability, sexual orientation, gender identity, or immigration status; and

**WHEREAS**, the **County of San Mateo** rejects and condemns hate of any kind; and

**WHEREAS**, we affirm our belief that a future of greater safety, stronger communities, and increased prosperity is possible through solidarity, partnership, and unity; and

**WHEREAS**, this Board wishes to join other cities, counties, and municipalities in the Bay Area and across the United States in celebrating **United Against Hate Week**; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED** that the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, hereby designates October 19-25, 2025 as **United Against Hate Week** in San Mateo County.
