RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH STARVISTA FOR THE OPERATION OF THE LESBIAN, GAY, BISEXUAL, TRANSGENDER, AND QUESTIONING AND OTHER GENDER IDENTITIES (LGBTQ+) BEHAVIORAL HEALTH COORDINATED CENTER FOR THE TERM OF OCTOBER 1, 2024, THROUGH JUNE 30, 2026, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$1,678,140

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, on March 8, 2024, Behavioral Health and Recovery Services

(BHRS) released a Request for Proposals seeking qualified contractors to operate the Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transgender and Questioning and other Gender Identities

(LGBTQ+) Behavioral Health Coordinated Center; and

WHEREAS, there has been presented to this Board of Supervisors for its consideration and acceptance an agreement, reference to which is hereby made for further particulars, whereby StarVista shall provide services for individuals at high risk for serious mental illness and work to improve LGBTQ+ quality of life and improve access to behavioral health services in the county, for the period October 1, 2024 through June 30, 2026, for a maximum obligation of \$1,678,140; and

WHEREAS, this Board has been presented with the agreement and has approved it as to both form and content and desires to enter into the agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the President of this Board of Supervisors be and is hereby authorized and directed to execute said agreement for and on behalf of the County of San Mateo, and the Clerk of this Board shall attest the President's signature thereto.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chief of San Mateo County Health or designee is authorized to execute contract amendments which modify the County's maximum fiscal obligation by no more than \$25,000 (in aggregate), and/or modify the contract term and/or services so long as the modified term or services is/are within the current or revised fiscal provisions.
