**WHEREAS, Kevin Woodhouse** has served as City Manager for the City of Pacifica for eight years from 2017 to 2026, and before that worked for the City of Mountain View and the Midpeninsula Regional Open Space District; and

**WHEREAS, Kevin Woodhouse** has successfully led the City of Pacifica in a thoughtful and strategic way for both short- and long-term planning and has shown a strong commitment to sustainability for both the residents and visitors of Pacifica; and

**WHEREAS, Kevin Woodhouse** has led the vision for a sustainable Pacifica in developing and prioritizing the Plan Pacifica initiative, which resulted in a Comprehensive General Plan Update, Local Coastal Land Use Plan Update, Housing Element, and a Sharp Park Specific Plan, all of which will guide new and redevelopment in Pacifica years to come; and

**WHEREAS, Kevin Woodhouse** initiated the creation of a robust annual Pacifica City Council strategic planning and tracking process, and completion of an Economic Opportunities Study, Economic Development Strategic Plan, and the award-winning Vision 2025 strategy; and

**WHEREAS, Kevin Woodhouse** has significantly improved, developed, and implemented the Pacifica infrastructure project, including street repaving, sidewalks, storm and wastewater systems, and the completion of the Civic Center Renovation Project; and

**WHEREAS, Kevin Woodhouse** led the City of Pacifica's efforts on coastal infrastructure protection, building of a new library, and the Climate Action and Resilience Plan; and

**WHEREAS, Kevin Woodhouse** was recognized for several awards during his tenure as Pacifica City Manager, including the APWA Silicon Valley 2025 Award for Project of the Year in Historical Restoration/Preservation Category, the 2025 Helen Putnam Award for Excellence from the League of Cities in the internal Administration Category, and the 2024 California Association of Local Economic Development Grand Prize Award of Excellence; and

**WHEREAS, Kevin Woodhouse** will undertake a new role as President of the City/County Management Association after his retirement from the City of Pacifica.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, hereby thanks **KEVIN WOODHOUSE** for his dedication and commitment to the constituents he has served over the past 35 years, recognizes his achievements and efforts as City Manager for the City of Pacifica, and wishes him all the success in his future endeavors.
