PROCLAMATION DESIGNATING SEPTEMBER 21-27, 2024

United Against Hate Week

WHEREAS, the United States is a diverse nation, strengthened by values of pluralism and multiculturalism, especially in San Mateo County; and

WHEREAS, the County of San Mateo is particularly proud of the vibrant tapestry of cultures, identities, and perspectives that are woven together in our communities; and

WHEREAS, the County of San Mateo stands against acts of hate, intimidation, and bigotry; and

WHEREAS, the County of San Mateo affirms the rights and the value of all residents regardless of race, ethnicity, disability, gender identity, sexual orientation, religion, socioeconomic status, immigration status or country of birth; and

WHEREAS, the County of San Mateo rejects efforts to divide, exclude, or marginalize individuals, families, or communities; and

WHEREAS, we recognize that our strength as a County and as a nation is rooted in collaboration and cooperation across differences; and

WHEREAS, this Board wishes to join other cities, counties, and municipalities in the Bay Area and the rest of the nation in recognizing **United Against Hate Week** and underscoring our County’s commitment to safety, inclusion, and belonging for all residents.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED that the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, hereby designates September 21-27, 2024 as United Against Hate Week in San Mateo County.
