

**THIRD AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT  
BETWEEN THE COUNTY OF SAN MATEO AND  
REDWOOD TOXICOLOGY LABORATORY, INC**

THIS THIRD AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT, entered into this 27th day of January 2026, by and between the COUNTY OF SAN MATEO, hereinafter called "County," and REDWOOD TOXICOLOGY LABORATORY, INC, hereinafter called "Contractor";

**W I T N E S S E T H:**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Government Code, Section 31000, County may contract with independent contractors for the furnishing of such services to or for County or any Department thereof;

WHEREAS, the parties entered into an Agreement for blood and urine testing for prosecution cases services on October 01, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the parties wish to amend the Agreement to a new total of \$229,999.00 and extend the contract term through March 30, 2026.

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY AGREED BY THE PARTIES HERETO AS FOLLOWS:**

- 1. Section 3 of the agreement is amended to read as follows:**

In no event shall County's total fiscal obligation under this Agreement exceed two hundred twenty-nine thousand nine hundred ninety-nine dollars. (\$229,999.00)

- 2. Section 4 of the agreement is amended to read as follows:**

Subject to compliance with all terms and conditions, the term of this Agreement shall be from October 01, 2025, through March 30, 2026.


