- Transparent use of funds



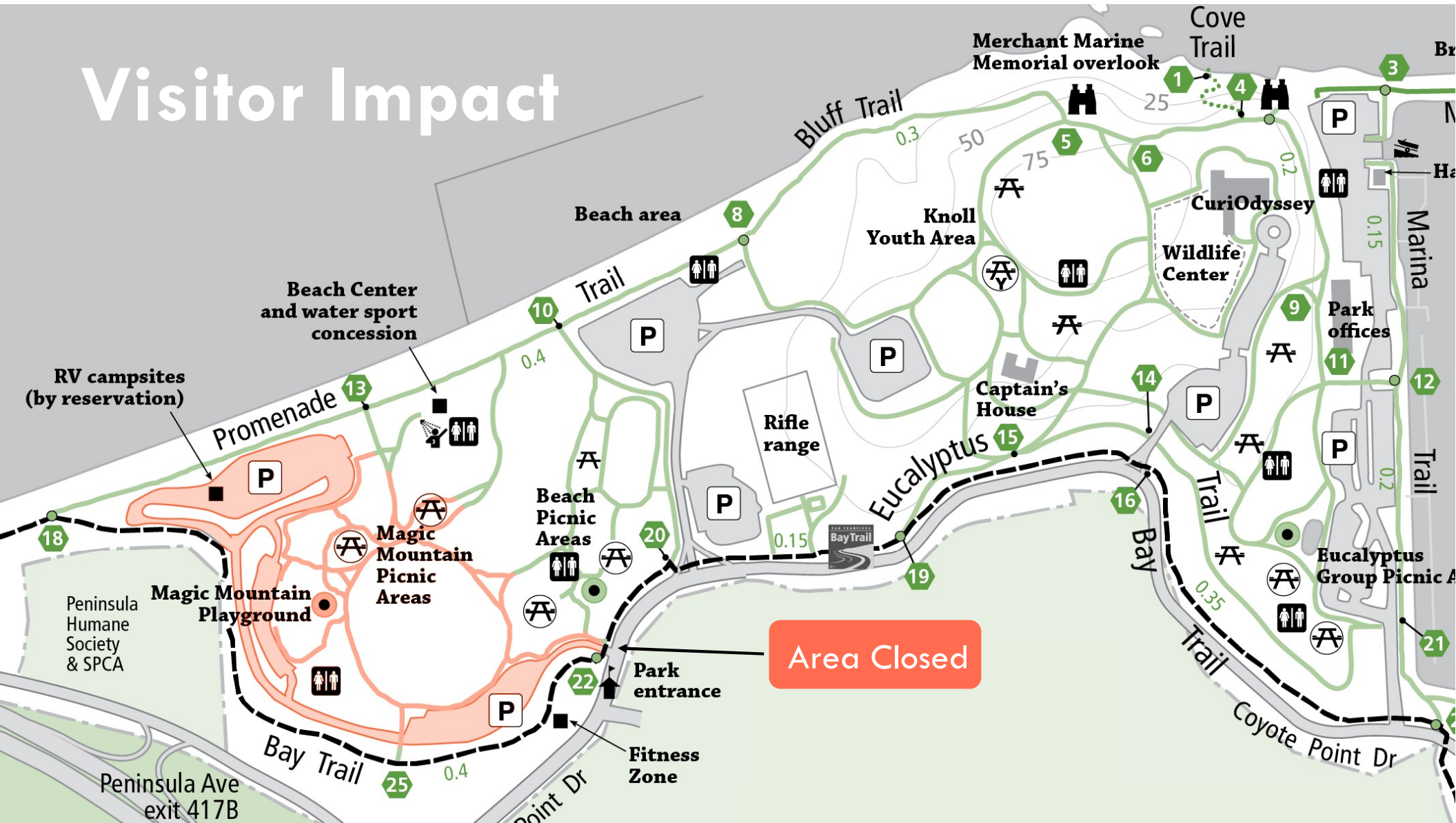

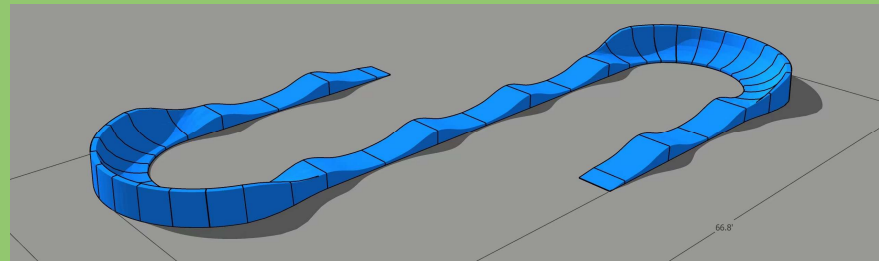
