RESOLUTION HONORING AND COMMENDING

David A. Silberman

*Upon His Appointment to the San Mateo County Superior Court
After Twenty-Two Years of Dedicated Service to the Public*

WHEREAS, David A. Silberman was born in San Francisco and was raised in San Mateo County by parents who still reside here; and

WHEREAS, David completed his undergraduate studies at the University of California, Davis and he received his law degree from the University of California at Los Angeles, after which he served as a law clerk for federal judges at the trial court and appellate levels and then worked for the law firm of Howard, Rice, Nemerovski, Canaday, Falk & Rabkin; and

WHEREAS, David began his distinguished career with the County of San Mateo in 2004 when he joined the Office of the County Counsel as a Deputy County Counsel; and

WHEREAS, David steadily advanced through a series of increasingly responsible positions within the Office of the County Counsel, now called the Office of the County Attorney, serving as a Deputy County Counsel, Chief Deputy County Attorney, and Assistant County Attorney, demonstrating throughout his career an exceptional commitment to public service, the welfare of his colleagues, and the rule of law; and

WHEREAS, David always willingly and energetically took on the most challenging roles, and he especially distinguished himself through his outstanding and skilled work as a civil litigator, which has been recognized statewide, as demonstrated by his many years of leadership in the County Counsel Association's Litigation section; and

WHEREAS, David has zealously represented numerous county departments, including Children and Family Services, the Public Guardian, Environmental Health, and the Sheriff's Office and **David** is recognized statewide for his expertise in law enforcement matters; and

WHEREAS, among the many high profile and historically significant matters that he worked on, David provided key legal support for the formation and establishment of Peninsula Clean Energy, a Community Choice Aggregator founded in 2016 to provide electricity that is more sustainable and lower in cost than traditional utilities and **David's** efforts helped to place PCE on a firm legal footing from the outset; and

WHEREAS, David, who has long resided in San Carlos, is grounded in the community as evidenced by his many years of service on the San Carlos Planning Commission, his service on the Board of Trustees of Peninsula Temple Shalom, his years of leadership with the San Mateo County Bar Association, his volunteering with Canine Companions for Independence, and his coaching of his children's soccer team; and

WHEREAS, David's legal acumen, professional integrity, analytical skills and impressive work ethic have earned him the deep admiration of colleagues, peers, and the legal community across the region, including the San Mateo County Board of Supervisors and **David** will be leaving his employment with the County of San Mateo to serve as a Judge with the San Mateo County Superior Court.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo does hereby recognize, honor, and extend its profound gratitude to **David A.
