PROCLAMATION DESIGNATING AUGUST AS

CHILD SUPPORT AWARENESS MONTH

PROCLAIMED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, the County of San Mateo is committed to ensuring the well-being of children helping them to become healthy, productive, and well-adjusted adults; and

WHEREAS, child support payments not only fulfill a legal responsibility, but also reduce the need for public assistance and are an essential component of promoting the financial stability and development of children, as they help to meet the basic needs of children, and provide access to healthcare, education, and other vital services; and

WHEREAS, the County of San Mateo recognizes the importance of raising awareness about the significance of child support in strengthening families, encouraging responsible parenting, and ensuring a brighter future for our children; and
