

**FOURTH AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT
BETWEEN THE COUNTY OF SAN MATEO
AND PENINSULA FAMILY SERVICE**

THIS FOURTH AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT, entered into this _____ day of _____, 2023, by and between the COUNTY OF SAN MATEO, hereinafter called "County," and Peninsula Family Service, hereinafter called "Agency";

WITNESSETH:

Whereas, pursuant to Section 31000 of the California Government Code, County may contract with independent contractors for the furnishing of such services to or for County or any Department thereof; and

WHEREAS, the parties entered into an agreement on September 29, 2020, for senior peer counseling services for the term July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2022 and Help@Hand Peer-led Outreach and Engagement for the term of July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2021, in an amount not to exceed \$986,784; and

WHEREAS, on January 25, 2021, the agreement was amended to add services of technology support for clients and family members that do not have the resources to purchase the technology they need to participate in telehealth services and online groups, increasing the amount of the agreement by \$2,958 to \$989,742, with no change to the agreement term; and

WHEREAS, on September 14, 2021, the agreement was amended a second time to extend the term of the Help@Hand Peer-led Outreach and Engagement services through June 30, 2022, and increase the amount of the agreement by \$300,000 to an amount not to exceed \$1,289,742; and

WHEREAS, on May 17, 2022, the agreement was amended a third time to 1) add digital inclusion for older adults (Get App-y Workshops) services, increase the contract amount by \$40,102, increase the agreement amount by \$272,440 for the Help@Hand Peer-led Outreach and Engagement services, and increase the agreement amount by \$374,616 for senior peer counseling services, to a new maximum total amount not to exceed \$1,976,900, and 2) extend the term of the agreement through June 30, 2023.

WHEREAS, the parties wish to increase the agreement by \$471,159 for a total amount not to exceed \$2,448,059, and to extend term of the agreement for nine months through March 31, 2024;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY AGREED BY THE PARTIES HERETO AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. Section 3. Payments** of the agreement is amended to read as follows:

In consideration of the services provided by Contractor in accordance with all terms, conditions and specifications set forth herein and in Exhibit "A3," County shall make payment to Contractor based on the rates and in the manner specified in Exhibit "B3." The County reserves the right to withhold payment if the County determines that the quantity or quality of the work performed is unacceptable. In no event shall the County's total fiscal obligation under this Agreement exceed TWO MILLION FOUR HUNDRED FORTY-EIGHT THOUSAND FIFTY-NINE DOLLARS (\$2,448,059).

- 2. Section 4. Term** of the agreement is amended to read as follows:

Subject to compliance with all terms and conditions, the term of this Agreement shall be from July 1, 2020 through March 31, 2024

- 3.** All other terms and conditions of the agreement, as previously amended, between the County and Agency shall remain in full force and effect.
