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**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT WITH
SANJAY & ARCHANA BINDRA MDS INC TO INCREASE THE AMOUNT OF THE
AGREEMENT BY \$47,843 TO AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$1,965,007 WITH NO
CHANGE TO THE AGREEMENT TERM**

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, San Mateo Medical Center (SMMC) has a continuing need for non-invasive cardiology specialty medical care; and

WHEREAS, on January 5, 2021, the County and Sanjay & Archana Bindra MDs Inc entered into an agreement whereby Dr. Bindra agreed to provide non-invasive cardiology services for the term of February 1, 2021, through January 31, 2024; and

WHEREAS, the County and Dr. Bindra amended the Agreement three times expanding coverage services and increasing the amount of the agreement to an amount not to exceed \$1,917,164; and

WHEREAS, the maximum amount authorized to be expended under the agreement was insufficient to fully compensate Dr. Bindra for staffing an expansion of Saturday cardiology clinics in early 2023 through the end of his agreement term on January 31, 2024 and the parties therefore desire to further amend the agreement to increase the maximum amount payable by \$47,843 to an amount not to exceed \$1,965,007 to permit Dr. Bindra's compensation to be duly reviewed, approved, and paid in accordance with County policy; and

WHEREAS, this Board has been presented with such an amendment, has examined and approved it as both form and content, and desires to enter into it.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the President of the Board of Supervisors be and is hereby authorized and directed to execute said amendment to the agreement for and on behalf of the County of San Mateo, and the Clerk of the Board shall attest the President's signature thereto.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chief of San Mateo County Health or designee is authorized to execute contract amendments which modify the County's maximum fiscal obligation by no more than \$25,000 (in aggregate) and/or modify the contract term and/or services so long as the modified term or services is/are within the current or revised fiscal provisions.

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
