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RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH BAY AREA COMMUNITY SERVICES FOR ADULT AND OLDER ADULT FULL-SERVICE PARTNERSHIP SERVICES, FOR THE TERM OF JULY 1, 2026 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2028, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$5,229,997

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, in July 2023, Behavioral Health and Recovery Services (BHRS) issued a Request for Proposals (RFP) seeking qualified adult and older adult full-service partnership services; and

WHEREAS, Telecare Corporation, Caminar, Inc., and Bay Area Community Services (BACS), were selected to provide adult and older adult full-service partnership services; and

WHEREAS, in May 2025, the Board of Supervisors approved two separate agreements with Telecare Corporation and Caminar, Inc., to provide adult and older adult full-service partnership services based on their of their diverse and established community collaborations, with peer organizations, and with housing providers; and

WHEREAS, the agreement with BACS was not able to move forward with a recommendation for award due to extended and ongoing negotiations with this new, out of county provider; and

WHEREAS, BHRS now desires to expand the full-service partnership program

for adult and older adult full-service partnership services; and

WHEREAS, BHRS desires to enter into an agreement with BACS, to provide adult and older adult full-service partnership services, for the term of July 1, 2026 through June 30, 2028, in an amount not to exceed \$5,229,997; and

WHEREAS, this has been presented to this Board of Supervisors for its consideration and acceptance an agreement, reference to which is hereby made for further particulars, whereby BACS shall provide adult and older adult full-service partnership services, for the term of July 1, 2026 through June 30, 2028, in an amount not to exceed \$5,229,997; and

WHEREAS, this Board has been presented with a form of such an agreement, has examined and approved it as to both form and content, and desires to enter into the agreement.

NOW , THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the President of this Board of Supervisors is hereby authorized and directed to execute said agreement for and on behalf of the County of San Mateo, and the Clerk of this Board shall attest the President's signature thereto.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chief of San Mateo County Health or designee is authorized to execute contract amendment which modify the County's maximum fiscal obligation by no more than \$25,0000 (in aggregate), and/or modify the contract term and/or services so long as the modified term or services is/are within the current or revised fiscal provisions.

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
