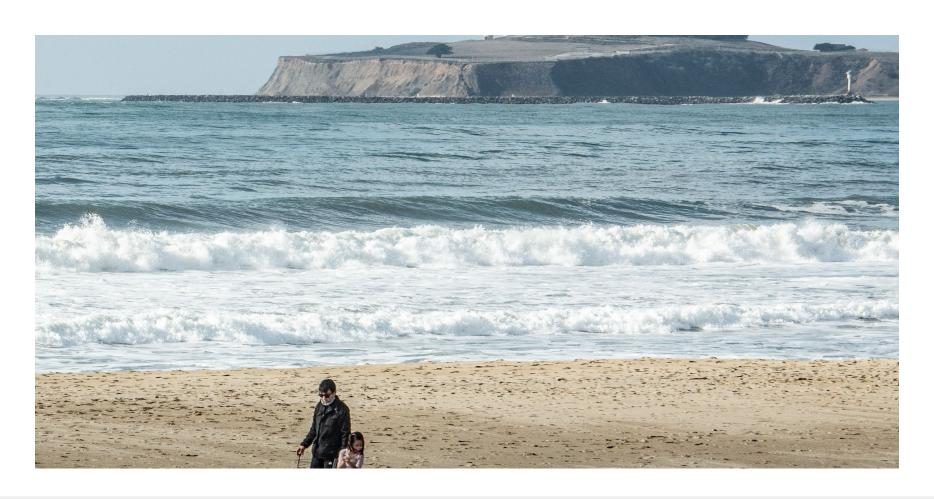

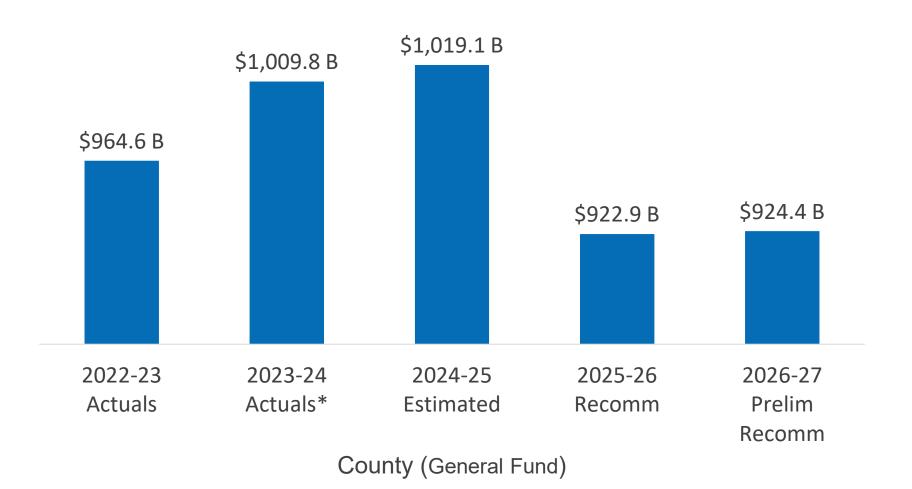

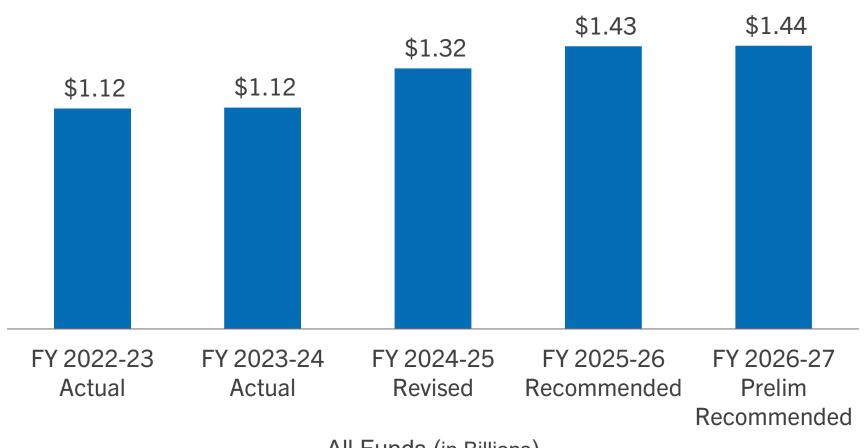




Ongoing Revenue



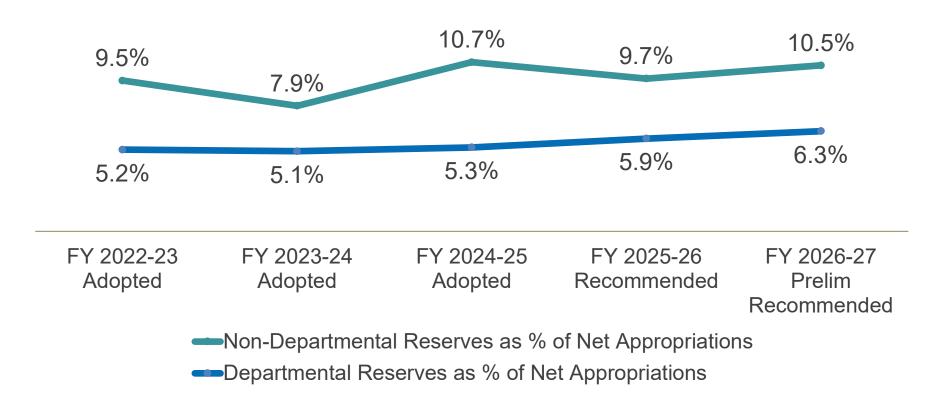

Eight Year Projections (Full VLFAA)



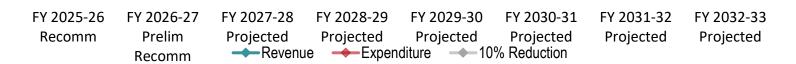




Eight Year Projections (Reduced VLFAA) 10% State and Federal Reductions
