RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SHERIFF OR SHERIFF'S DESIGNEE TO RENEW AND EXECUTE INTERAGENCY AGREEMENTS WITH OTHER PUBLIC AGENCIES, FOR A TERM OF NOVEMBER 1, 2024 THROUGH JULY 31, 2026, EACH IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$500,000, FOR A TOTAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$5,857,265, UTILIZING SOLELY THE \$5,857,265 OF FUNDING FROM THE FY 2024 URBAN AREA SECURITY INITIATIVE (UASI) GRANT FOR THE PURPOSE OF REIMBURSING THOSE AGENCIES FOR THE COST OF PERSONNEL ASSIGNED TO THE NORTHERN CALIFORNIA REGIONAL INTELLIGENCE CENTER (NCRIC)

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, the County of San Mateo has previously received federal Department of Homeland Security grant funds through the Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI) program for which the City and County of San Francisco acts as the regional administrator and contracts with the recipient agencies for the distribution of funds; and

WHEREAS, on February 11, 2025, through Resolution No. 080926, the Board authorized execution of an agreement with the City and County of San Francisco for the distribution of FY 2024 Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI) grant funds for the Northern California Regional Intelligence Center (NCRIC) in an amount not to exceed \$5,857,265, and authorized the Sheriff or Sheriff's designee to execute interagency agreements with other public agencies in amounts that do not exceed \$350,000 each, utilizing solely the \$5,857,265 in grant funds, for the purpose of reimbursing those agencies for the cost of personnel assigned to the NCRIC; and

WHEREAS, due to actions by the Federal government directed at “sanctuary jurisdictions,” funding that would normally go to the NCRIC has been delayed indefinitely; and

WHEREAS, to lessen the negative impact of the funding decision delays, and allow the NCRIC to continue its operations, the NCRIC has modified its FY 2024 UASI budget that was accepted by the Board on February 11, 2025, to include additional funding for interagency personnel assigned to the NCRIC.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the Sheriff or Sheriff’s designee is hereby authorized to renew and execute interagency agreements with other public agencies in amounts that do not exceed \$500,000 each, utilizing solely the \$5,857,265 of grant funding from the FY 2024 Urban Area Security Initiative grant, for the purpose of reimbursing those agencies for the cost of personnel assigned to the Northern California Regional Intelligence Center.
