RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE TEAMSTER WORKERS ENGAGED IN A LABOR DISPUTE WITH THEIR EMPLOYER, FLYING FOOD GROUP, WHICH PROVIDES FOOD SERVICE TO AIRLINES AT THE SAN FRANCISCO INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT

WHEREAS, members of Teamsters Local 2785 are employed as truck drivers and helpers at Flying Food Group and the San Francisco International Airport (SFO); and

WHEREAS, these workers are responsible for performing their duties responsibly and with punctuality to ensure seamless and safe operations at SFO; and

WHEREAS, these workers have been on strike since the beginning of April in an effort to maintain adequate economic security and affordable health care for themselves and their families; and

WHEREAS, Flying Food Group has not offered economic compensation to adequately meet the expectations of these workers, nor have they been negotiating in good faith, which in turn has prolonged this labor dispute; and

WHEREAS, The County of San Mateo recognizes the importance of labor harmony and the rights of workers to organize and advocate for fair treatment, and is committed to supporting worker protections and equitable labor practices;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of San Mateo County hereby recognizes the essential and difficult work performed by members of Teamsters Local 2785 at Flying Foods; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that San Mateo County Board of Supervisors urges the parties to immediately resume good faith bargaining so that these workers can return to work with dignity and economic security.
