**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH PEREGRINE
TECHNOLOGIES, INC, FOR THE TERM OF JANUARY 31, 2026 THROUGH JULY
31, 2027, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$3,386,218**

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RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, Peregrine Technologies, Inc. (Peregrine) is a US-based company that provides a law enforcement and public safety software platform designed to centralize data from multiple disparate sources into a single, unified repository; and

WHEREAS, Peregrine has been widely adopted by public safety agencies throughout the Bay Area and a County-wide use of this platform will support the development and operation of the Real-Time Crime/Intelligence Center and enhance regional collaboration efforts aimed at improving public safety outcomes; and

WHEREAS, the police departments of Atherton, Belmont, Brisbane, Broadmoor, Burlingame, Colma, Daly City, East Palo Alto, Foster City, Hillsborough, Menlo Park, Pacifica, Redwood City, San Bruno, San Mateo and South San Francisco, as well as the San Mateo County Sheriff's Office and the District Attorney's Office have agreed to jointly adopt the Peregrine system to enhance collaboration across the County and the County has agreed to fund the initial 18 months of a 40-month agreement with Peregrine; and

WHEREAS, following the initial 18-month period, individual agencies may elect to continue participation by funding their respective portions of the contract costs; and

WHEREAS, the agreement includes platform licensing for all agency staff and integration with each agency's computer-aided dispatch (CAD) data, records management system (RMS) data, digital evidence via Axon Evidence.com, the Sheriff's Office's jail management system (JMS), and select agencies' drone-as-first-responder (DFR) data; and

WHEREAS, staff utilized the results of the City of Alhambra's competitive solicitation process, which was conducted in the Fall of 2024, and County Procurement has concluded that this process satisfies the requirements of the County and therefore it is in the County's interest to waive a separate and repetitive Request for Proposal process.

WHEREAS, this Board has been presented with the agreement and has approved it as to both form and content and desires to enter into the agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the Board of Supervisors authorizes the President of the Board of Supervisors to execute an agreement with Peregrine Technologies, Inc., utilizing the City of Alhambra's prior competitive solicitation process, for the term of January 31, 2026 through July 31, 2027, in an amount not to exceed \$3,386,218.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Sheriff or designee, is authorized to execute additional contract amendments in the amount not to exceed \$25,000 which modify terms, conditions, and or services, of the agreement including but not limited to additional third-party integrations.

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
