BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, COUNTY OF SAN MATEO, STATE OF CALIFORNIA

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ADOPT A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH !ACHIEVE SUCCESS FOR YOUTH TUTORING SERVICES FOR THE TERM OF JULY 1, 2018 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2020 IN THE AMOUNT OF \$240,000

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, San Mateo County's Shared Vision of 2025 has established the initiative to provide support towards stability and self-sufficiency for low-income and vulnerable populations;

WHEREAS, the Human Services Agency seeks to address these initiatives by increasing the high school graduation rates for dependent foster youth who participate in educational services and by providing tutoring services to improve academic performance of foster youth; and

WHEREAS, On January 29, 2018, the Human Services Agency issued a Request for Proposals for tutoring services and selected !Achieve Success as the provider that would best met the needs of the County based on their experience and their ability to provide specialized tutoring that address children with multiple educational needs including low performing students, students with disabilities, foster youth and/or English language learners; and

WHEREAS, !Achieve Success will provide up to 4,800 hours of tutoring services for a minimum of 25 youth in San Mateo County enrolled in grades K-12 in the areas of general education and test preparation; and

WHEREAS, there has been presented to this Board of Supervisors for its consideration and acceptance an Agreement, reference to which is hereby made for further particulars, in an amount not to exceed \$240,000, for the term of July 1, 2018 through June 30, 2020; and

WHEREAS, this Board has approved the Agreement as to both form and content and desires to enter into the Agreement.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the President of this Board of Supervisors be and is hereby authorized and directed to execute said Agreement for and on behalf of the County of San Mateo, and the Clerk of this Board shall attest the President's signature thereto.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of the Human Services Agency or his/her designee is authorized to execute amendments which modify the County's maximum fiscal obligation by no more than \$25,000 (in aggregate), and/or modify the Agreement and/or services so long as the modified term or services is/are within the current or revised fiscal provisions.

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
