**BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, COUNTY OF SAN MATEO, STATE OF CALIFORNIA**

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**RESOLUTION A) ADOPTING THE CONSTRUCTION TASK CATALOG, SPECIFICATIONS, AND CONFORMANCE WITH PREVAILING WAGE SCALE REQUIREMENTS FOR THE 2022 JOB ORDER CONTRACTS FOR ENGINEERING, CONSTRUCTION, ROADS, AND UTILITIES; AND**

**B) AUTHORIZING AGREEMENTS WITH GRANITE ROCK COMPANY, ANDREINI BROTHERS, INC., AND CATO'S GENERAL ENGINEERING, INC. FOR ENGINEERING, CONSTRUCTION, ROADS AND UTILITIES, FOR THE TERM OF MARCH 8, 2022 THROUGH MARCH 7, 2023, EACH IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$5,000,000; AND**

**C) AUTHORIZE THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS, OR THE DIRECTOR'S DESIGNEE, TO ISSUE WORK/JOB ORDERS, EXECUTE CHANGE/REVISION ORDERS, AND MAKE FINANCIAL AND ADMINISTRATIVE CHANGES TO EXECUTED JOB ORDER CONTRACT AGREEMENTS**

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**RESOLVED**, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

**WHEREAS**, this Board of Supervisors did, on November 19, 2013, adopt Resolution No. 072896, which authorized a streamlined process for Job Order Contracts (JOC), which allows for the preparation of the construction task catalog, specifications and bid documents in conformance with prevailing wage scale requirements for JOCs, advertising for bids, and adoption of the construction task catalog and specifications by the Board at the time the resulting JOC is considered for award; and

**WHEREAS**, the Construction Task Catalog and Specifications, dated January 2022, were prepared and approved by the Director of Public Works for the 2022 Job Order Contracts for Engineering, Construction, Roads, and Utilities; and

**WHEREAS**, the Construction Task Catalog and Specifications, require that the contractors performing the work pay not less than the general prevailing wages, as established by the Department of Industrial Relations, in the locality in which said work is to be performed for each type of workman needed to execute the contract; and

**WHEREAS**, Public Contract Code Section 20128.5 provides that this Board of Supervisors may award individual annual "Job Order" contracts, none of which shall exceed three million dollars (\$3,000,000), adjusted annually to reflect the percentage change in the California Consumer Price Index (CPI), for repair, remodeling, or other repetitive work to be done according to unit prices. Since the statute was enacted in 1997, the application of the CPI allows the current maximum amount of \$5,600,000 for annual JOCs; and

**WHEREAS**, the Department of Public Works issued a call for sealed proposals to be received at the County Manager/Clerk of Board of Supervisors, Hall of Justice and Records, 400 County Center, Redwood City, California, until the hour of 2:30 p.m. on Tuesday, February 22, 2022; and

**WHEREAS**, the Department of Public Works caused the notice inviting sealed proposals to be published two (2) times in the Examiner Peninsula Newspaper Group, a newspaper printed and published in this County, and obtained an affidavit of said publication; and

**WHEREAS**, the Deputy Clerk of this Board of Supervisors, in public on February 22, 2022 at 2:30 p.m., opened and examined all sealed bids that were received in the specified time for doing the work referred to in said Construction Task Catalog and Specifications; and

**WHEREAS**, this Board of Supervisors has caused an analysis of said sealed proposals to be made by the Director of Public Works of the County of San Mateo, and has, in open session, fully reviewed and considered said proposals and the analysis thereof; and

**WHEREAS**, Granite Rock Company, Andreini Brothers, Inc., Cato's General Engineering, Inc., submitted the three (3) lowest responsible bids for JOC-2217, JOC-2218, and JOC-2219, respectively, for Engineering, Construction, Roads, and Utilities, and those bids consisting of an adjustment factor which is a multiplier to the adopted County's Construction Task Catalog preset unit prices.

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED** as follows:

1. The Construction Task Catalog and Specifications, dated January 2022, for the 2022 Job Order Contracts for Engineering, Construction, Roads, and Utilities are hereby approved and adopted as the Construction Task Catalog and Specifications to be adhered to in letting and performing the work under contracts for improvements described herein.

2. It is in the best interest of the County of San Mateo to award the 2022 Job Order Contracts for Engineering, Construction, Roads, and Utilities as follows:

3. The County of San Mateo shall enter into a written contract with these companies to perform said work as required by the Construction Task Catalog and Specifications adopted and approved by this Board of Supervisors, as hereinbefore mentioned, which Construction Task Catalog and Specifications are on file in the office of the Director of Public Works of the County of San Mateo.
4. The President of this Board of Supervisors shall be, and is hereby, authorized and directed to execute agreements with Granite Rock Company, Andreini Brothers, Inc., and Cato's General Engineering, Inc., for the doing of said work, as hereinbefore mentioned subject to the Department of Public Works' receipt and approval of the Faithful Performance Surety Bonds ("Performance Bond") and the

Labor and Material Surety Bonds (“Payment Bond”) required to be posted by the said Contractor with the County of San Mateo in connection therewith.

5. All payments to the Contractors shall be in accordance with the Construction Task Catalog and Specifications, and other contract documents. Aggregate payments to the Contractors under these three contracts shall not exceed the sum of \$5,000,000 each.
6. The Clerk of the Board of Supervisors, County of San Mateo, shall be, and is hereby, authorized and directed to attest the signature of the President of this Board of Supervisors to said written agreements.
7. The Director of Public Works of the County of San Mateo, or the Director’s designee, is hereby authorized and directed to issue and execute Job Orders and Change/Revision Orders, as described herein.
8. The Director of Public Works of the County of San Mateo, or the Director’s designee, is hereby authorized to make financial and administrative changes to executed Job Order Contract agreements and execute contract amendments which modify the contract term and/or services so long as the modified term or services is/are within the adopted fiscal provisions.

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
