April 22, 2024 as

Earth Day

WHEREAS, April 22 has been recognized annually in the United States as EARTH DAY since 1970, as a result of Wisconsin Senator Gaylord Nelson's recognition of the ongoing damage to Santa Barbara's beaches resulting from a massive oil spill in 1969; and

WHEREAS, the County of San Mateo recognizes that the Earth supports an incredibly complex, vibrant and abundant ecosystem upon which we all depend, and recognizes the responsibility to act as a steward to the environment for the good of its constituents, the planet and future generations; and
