

AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT

BETWEEN THE COUNTY OF SAN MATEO AND PACIFICA RESOURCE CENTER

THIS AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT, entered into this ____ day of _____, 2019, by and between the COUNTY OF SAN MATEO, hereinafter called "County," and Pacifica Resource Center, hereinafter called "Contractor";

W I T N E S S E T H:

WHEREAS, pursuant to Government Code Section 31000, County may contract with independent contractors for the furnishing of such services to or for County or any Department thereof; and

WHEREAS, on November 15, 2016, the parties entered into an agreement (the "Agreement"), by Resolution No. 074891d, for Contractor to provide Core Agency Services to at risk and homeless residents for the term of November 15, 2016 to June 30, 2019 for a total obligation of \$372,625; and

WHEREAS, the parties wish to amend the Agreement to allow Contractor to continue providing these Core Agency Services for an extended term through June 30, 2021 in exchange for an additional \$295,253 for a total obligation amount not to exceed \$667,878.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY AGREED BY THE PARTIES HERETO AS FOLLOWS:

1. Paragraph 1. Exhibits and Attachments of the Agreement is hereby amended as follows:

2. Paragraph 3. Payments of the Agreement is hereby amended to read as follows:

In consideration of the services provided by Contractor in accordance with all terms, conditions, and specifications set forth in this Agreement and in Exhibit A, County shall make payment to Contractor based on the rates and in the manner specified in **Exhibit B (revised June 2019)**. County reserves the right to withhold payment if County

determines that the quantity or quality of the work performed is unacceptable. In no event shall County's total fiscal obligation under this Agreement exceed **SIX HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN THOUSAND AND EIGHT HUNDRED SEVENTY-EIGHT DOLLARS** (\$667,878). In the event that County makes any advance payments, Contractor agrees to refund any amounts in excess of the amount owed by County at the time of contract termination or expiration. Contractor is not entitled to payment for work not performed as required by this Agreement.

3. Paragraph 4. Term of the Agreement is hereby amended as follows:

Subject to compliance with all terms and conditions, the term of this Agreement shall be from November 15, 2016 through **June 30, 2021**.
