**RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A 20-FOOT AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES ACT
(ADA) ACCESSIBLE PARKING ZONE AT 536 WARRINGTON AVENUE IN THE
UNINCORPORATED NORTH FAIR OAKS AREA**

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, California Vehicle Code Section 22507, et seq., and Section 7.44.010 of the San Mateo County Ordinance Code allow this Board of Supervisors to establish Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) disabled parking zone locations by resolution; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Works has recommended that a disabled (ADA) parking zone be established at 536 Warrington Avenue in the North Fair Oaks area of unincorporated Redwood City; and

WHEREAS, this Board has reviewed and concurs with the recommendation of the Director of Public Works.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED as follows:

1. A Disabled (ADA) Parking Zone is established at the address of 536 Warrington Avenue, Redwood City, on the south-easterly side of Warrington Avenue (County Road 669) commencing at approximately 262 feet north-east of the centerline of

San Mateo Avenue and extending north-easterly on Warrington Avenue a distance of 20 feet, more or less.

2. The Department of Public Works is authorized and directed to post any necessary signs and pavement markings.
