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RESOLUTION: A) SETTING TUESDAY, JANUARY 14, 2025, AT 9:30 A.M. AT THE REGULARLY SCHEDULED BOARD MEETING AS THE TIME AND PLACE FOR A PUBLIC HEARING ON THE GARBAGE AND RECYCLABLES COLLECTION PROPOSED RATES FOR UNINCORPORATED FRANCHISED AREA FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2025; AND DIRECT THE NECESSARY NOTICES FOR SAID HEARING

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

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California, that

WHEREAS, on October 20, 2009, the Board adopted Resolution No. 070423

which approved a franchise agreement with Recology San Mateo County (Recology) to

provide services for the collection of recyclable materials, organic materials, and

garbage in County Service Area No. 8 (CSA-8) and the Unincorporated County

Franchised Area (CFA) from January 1, 2011, through December 31, 2020; and

WHEREAS, on June 4, 2019, the Board adopted Resolution No. 076641

approving the amended and restated Recology Franchise Agreement for an additional

15-year term expiring on December 31, 2035; and

WHEREAS, on January 23, 2024, the Board adopted Resolution No. 080118, approving a 13.6 percent rate increase for CY 2024 for County Franchised Area (CFA), effective as of January 1, 2024; and

WHEREAS, the Director of the Sustainability Department has recommended garbage and recyclables collection rates for the CFA attached hereto as Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, the Franchise Agreement with Recology includes the Unscheduled Service Fees attached hereto as Exhibit B, which are services specifically requested and paid for by the ratepayer, are adjusted annually based upon the Consumer Price Index, and are in addition to the base collection rates; and

WHEREAS, the Constitution of the State of California requires that written notice of any proposed new or increased fees or property-related charges be provided by mail to the record owners of each parcel upon which the charges are proposed for imposition; and that the Unscheduled Service fees are excluded from this notice as they are not property-related fees subject to the Proposition 218 rate setting requirements; and

WHEREAS, in light of the proposed new rates for garbage and recycling collection, a written notice of the proposed rates and public hearing must be provided to the record owner of each parcel within the CFA to comply with Proposition 218 requirements; and

WHEREAS, a written notice of the public hearing will be posted in a newspaper of general circulation, attached hereto as Exhibit C.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED as follows:

 Tuesday, January 14, 2025, at 9:30 a.m. in the Chambers of the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, Redwood City, California, is hereby fixed as the time and place of the hearing on the garbage and recyclables collection rates for the CFA, effective January 1, 2025. Pursuant to Government Code Section 54953(e), the board meeting will be a hybrid meeting, open to the public for both in person participation and via Zoom online meeting format. Anyone interested may appear in person or via Zoom and be heard on this matter or may submit a written statement to the Clerk of the Board. - Director of the Sustainability Department shall cause a copy of the "NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING," attached hereto, to be published once a week for two successive weeks prior to the date set for the public hearing in a newspaper of general circulation.
- 3. Director of the Sustainability Department shall prepare a written notice of the proposed garbage and recyclables collection rates for CFA, which will be the basis for the imposition and collection of charges by Recology consistent with County Ordinance Codes, and that the notice be sent by mail to the record owner of each parcel within CFA.

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
