- Authorizing the President of the Board of Supervisors to execute a Real Estate Purchase and Sale Agreement and Escrow Instructions ("Agreement") for the County's acquisition of the Property for a total purchase price of \$21,500,000; and
- Authorizing the County Manager, or his designee, to execute the Certificate of Acceptance, as well as any and all notices, escrow instructions, and documents required to facilitate the purposes of the Agreement.
