RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PRESIDENT OF THE BOARD TO EXECUTE AN AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT WITH VRVC, LLC TO CONTINUE TO PROVIDE CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT SERVICES FOR COUNTY PROJECTS EXTENDING THE TERM OF THE AGREEMENT THROUGH NOVEMBER 30, 2024 AND INCREASING THE AMOUNT BY \$3,000,000 FOR A NEW NOT TO EXCEED AMOUNT OF \$5,517,000

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, on April 17, 2017, the PDU entered into an Agreement with VRVC, LLC (VRVC) to provide project management support related to projects under management by the Project Development Unit (PDU) based on VRVC's showing of the demonstrated competence and professional qualifications necessary for the performance of services at a fair and reasonable price; and

WHEREAS, subsequently, this Board executed three additional amendments increasing the original contract value by \$2,471,001 in aggregate for a revised contract value of \$2,571,000; and

WHEREAS, since that time, VRVC has continued to provide high quality project management services in support of the PDU mission and project success, including by managing the County's \$155,000,000 Cordilleras Health System Project; and

WHEREAS, the PDU wishes to execute an Amendment to extend the term of the VRVC agreement for project management services through November 30, 2024 and

increase the contract amount by \$3,000,000, establishing a new not to exceed amount of \$5,517,000; and

WHEREAS, County Procurement has reviewed and approved the extension of this agreement; and

WHEREAS, County Counsel has reviewed and approved the Resolution as to form.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors adopt a resolution authorizing the President of the Board or designee to execute an amendment with VRVC, LLC to increase the agreement amount by \$3,000,000 to a total amount of \$5,517,000 with all other terms and conditions remaining in effect.
