

# COVID Testing Drive Through Clinic

- The San Mateo Event Center serves San Mateo County as an OES (Office of Emergency Services Site) playing a vital role in protecting our health care workers and most vulnerable populations by service as a COVID-19 testing site, Housing Covid Positive patients in RV's, serving as an operations hub, supply center, and vaccine distribution. To date, the Event Center has administered 250,000 COVID-19 tests and vaccinated more than 100,000 individuals.

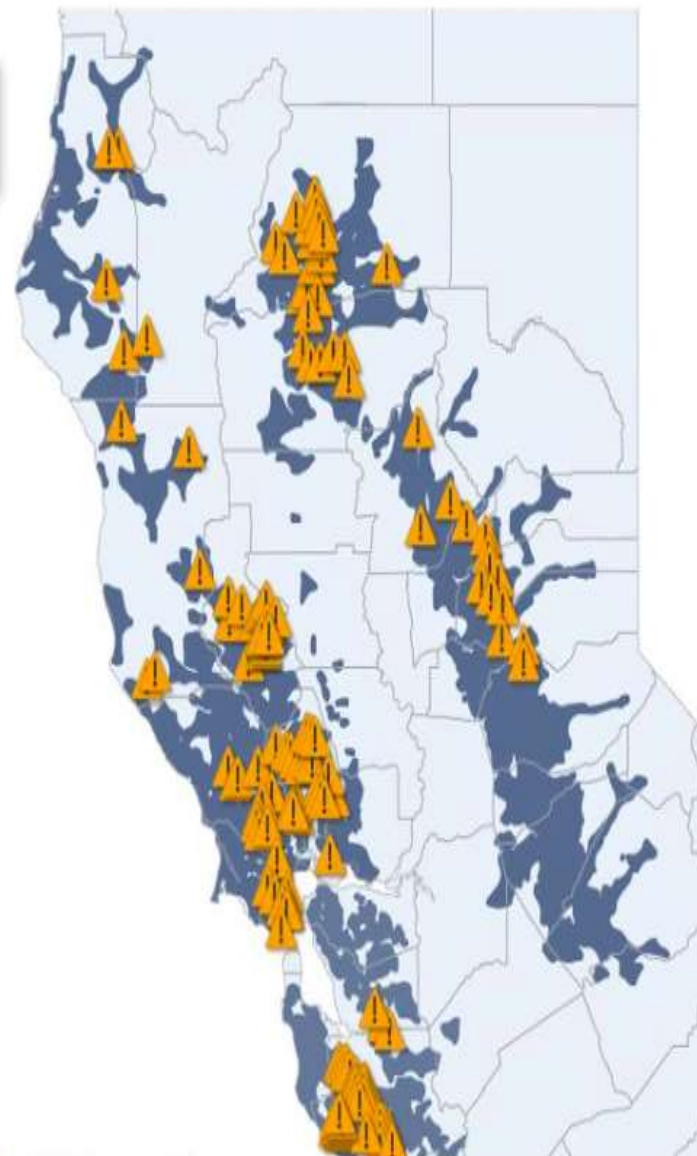

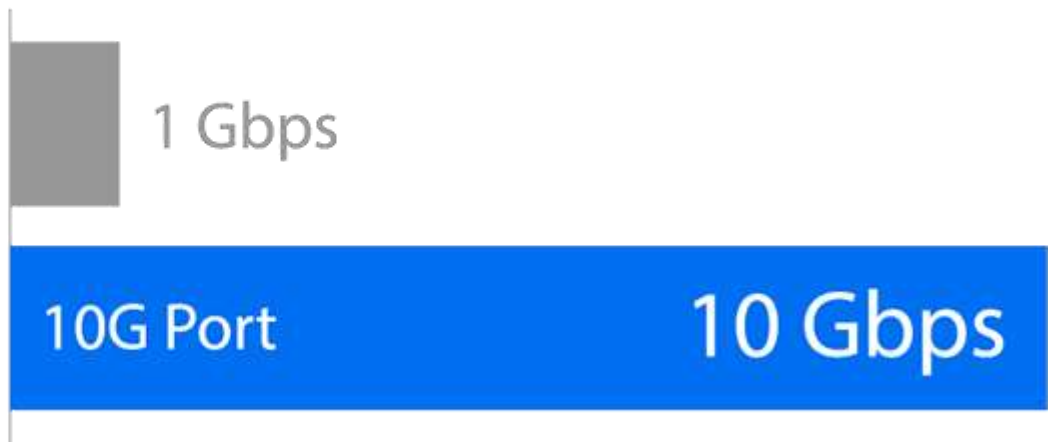
