Whereas, Brian Ham worked collectively with the volunteer fire brigades of Kings Mountain, La Honda, and Loma Mar to ensure the needs of the communities were met with safe and effective standards while ensuring they have the proper equipment to meet the correlative mission of CAL FIRE; and
