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RESOLUTION WAIVING THE REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS PROCESS AND AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT WITH PFM ASSET MANAGEMENT LLC TO CONTINUE PROVIDING INVESTMENT ADVISORY SERVICES, INCREASING THE AMOUNT BY \$3,000,000 TO AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$5,550,000 FOR THE TERM OF JULY 1, 2022, THROUGH JUNE 30, 2024

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, the Treasurer is charged with managing and protecting the County's financial assets while providing all pool participants with safety, liquidity and yield on their investments; and

WHEREAS, PFM Asset Management LLC ("PFMAM") was selected to provide investment advisory services and was awarded a contract under board resolution 076705; and

WHEREAS, the Treasurer's Office is contracting with PFMAM to provide research and supervision of the managed funds investments and conduct a continuous program of investment, evaluation and, when appropriate, sale and reinvestment of the managed funds assets and continuity in the provision of these services would be in the best interests of the County; and

WHEREAS, the County of San Mateo's Ordinance 2.83.050(f) allows the Board of Supervisors to waive the Request for Proposal (RFP) competitive bidding process in

any situation where the Board determines that a formal process would not be in the best interest of the County;

WHEREAS, there has been presented to this Board of Supervisors for its consideration and acceptance an amendment to the agreement whereby PFMAM shall provide investment advisory services beginning July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2024 in a not-to-exceed amount of \$5,550,000;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that

Request for Proposal process is waived and the President of the Board of

Supervisors be and is hereby authorized and directed to execute said Agreement for

and on behalf of the County of San Mateo, and the Clerk of the Board shall attest the

President's signature thereto.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Treasurer-Tax Collector or designee is authorized to execute contract amendments which modify the County's maximum fiscal obligation by no more than \$25,000 (in aggregate), and/or modify the contract term and/or services so long as the modified term or services are within the current or revised fiscal provisions.

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
