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RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT WITH JEFFERSON UNION HIGH SCHOOL DISTRICT FOR MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES, ALCOHOL AND OTHER DRUG PREVENTION SERVICES, AND THE DALY CITY YOUTH HEALTH CENTER COVID YOUTH RESILIENCY RESPONSE INITIATIVE, EXTENDING THE TERM THROUGH JUNE 30, 2023, AND INCREASING THE AMOUNT BY \$954,564, TO AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$2,114,182

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, on December 14, 2021, this Board approved an agreement with Jefferson Union High School District for mental health services, alcohol and other drug prevention services for July 1, 2021, through June 30, 2022, in an amount not to exceed \$1,159,618; and

WHEREAS, there has been presented to this Board of Supervisors for its consideration and acceptance an amendment to the agreement, reference to which is hereby made for further particulars, increasing the amount payable under the agreement by \$954,564 to a new maximum of \$2,114,182 and extending the term through June 30, 2023.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the President of this Board of Supervisors be and is hereby authorized and directed to

execute said amendment to the agreement for and on behalf of the County of San Mateo, and the Clerk of this Board shall attest the President's signature thereto.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chief of San Mateo County Health or designee is authorized to execute contract amendments which modify the County's maximum fiscal obligation by no more than \$25,000 (in aggregate), and/or modify the contract term and/or services so long as the modified term or services is/are within the current or revised fiscal provisions.

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
