## BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, COUNTY OF SAN MATEO, STATE OF CALIFORNIA

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## RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A FOURTH AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT WITH HRSUPPORT, TO INCREASE THE AMOUNT PAYABLE UNDER THE AGREEMENT BY \$2,200,000, TO AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$2,700,000, AND GRANTING OF A WAIVER OF THE COMPETITIVE BIDDING PROCESS PURSUANT TO COUNTY ORDINANCE 2.83.050(E)

**RESOLVED**, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, on March 3, 2020, the County's Health Officer issued a "Declaration of Local Health Emergency Regarding Novel Coronavirus 2019," and the County Manager, as the County's Director of Emergency Services (the "Director"), issued a proclamation of local emergency pursuant to Government Code section 8630 and Chapter 2.46 of the County's Ordinance Code, which proclamation was ratified by this Board on March 10, 2020, pursuant to Government Code section 8630, and extended by this Board on April 7, 2020, until such time as the local emergency is terminated (the "COVID-19 Local Emergency");

WHEREAS, in response to the COVID-19 Local Emergency, the County of San Mateo's Emergency Operations Center ("EOC") was engaged to assist in the County's response; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 077305 adopted by this Board in accordance with Government Code Section 25502.7, on January 22, 2021, the Director entered into an agreement with HRSupport ("Contractor") for the provision of community

vaccination clinics and homebound vaccine services for the County's COVID-19 response; and

WHEREAS, on March 13, 2021, the First Amendment was executed to add services for the vaccination of homebound residents and to revise the exhibits, on June 2, 2021, the Second Amendment was executed to revise the exhibits, on November 5, 2021 the Third Amendment was executed to extend the term of the agreement, revise the existing exhibits and increase the not to exceed amount to \$500,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the County has a continuing need for the support services provided for in the Agreement, and Contractor is willing and able to continue providing the services; and

WHEREAS, the Emergency Operations Center is requesting that this Board waive the formal solicitation process in order to ensure continuation of services to the public in response to the COVID-19 Local Emergency; and

WHEREAS, there has been presented to this Board for its consideration and approval a form of Fourth Amendment to the Agreement ("Amendment") pursuant to which the total amount authorized to be expended under the Agreement will be increased by \$2,200,000, to an amount not to exceed \$2,700,000; and

WHEREAS, this Board has reviewed the Amendment, considered it as to form and substance, and desires to enter into it.

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED** that the formal solicitation process for the services described in the Agreement is hereby waived

and the Director or the Director's designee is hereby authorized and directed to execute the Amendment for and on behalf of the County of San Mateo.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Director, or the Director's designee, is authorized to execute further amendments to the Agreement that modify the County's maximum fiscal obligation up to an additional \$25,000 (in the aggregate), and/or modify the contract term and/or services so long as the modified term and/or services is/are within the current or revised fiscal provisions, including, but not limited to, the modification or addition of any provisions that the Director deems necessary or advisable to comply with Federal Emergency Management Administration

(FEMA) reimbursement requirements.

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
