BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, COUNTY OF SAN MATEO, STATE OF CALIFORNIA

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RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT WITH SAN MATEO COUNTY EVENT EXPOSITION AND FAIR ASSOCIATION, DBA SAN MATEO EVENT CENTER, TO INCREASE THE AMOUNT PAYABLE UNDER THE AGREEMENT BY \$375,000, FROM \$500,000 TO AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$875,000, AND GRANTING OF A WAIVER OF THE COMPETITIVE BIDDING PROCESS PURSUANT TO COUNTY ORDINANCE 2.83.050(E)

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, on March 3, 2020, the County’s Health Officer issued a “Declaration of Local Health Emergency Regarding Novel Coronavirus 2019,” and the County Manager, as the County’s Director of Emergency Services (the “Director”), issued a proclamation of local emergency pursuant to Government Code Section 8630 and Chapter 2.46 of the County’s Ordinance Code, which proclamation was ratified by this Board on March 10, 2020, pursuant to Government Code Section 8630, and extended by this Board on April 7, 2020, until such time as the local emergency is terminated (the “COVID-19 Local Emergency”);

WHEREAS, in response to the COVID-19 Local Emergency, the County of San Mateo’s Emergency Operations Center (“EOC”) was engaged to assist in the County’s response; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 077305, adopted by this Board in accordance with Government Code Section 25502.7, effective January 1, 2022, the Director entered into an agreement with San Mateo County Event Exposition and Fair

Association, DBA San Mateo Event Center (“Event Center”) for the provision of facilities, personnel services, and supplies to house and support the County’s COVID-19 mass vaccination site through June 30, 2022 in an amount not to exceed \$500,000 (the “Agreement”); and

WHEREAS, the County has a continuing need for the above-described critical services provided for in the Agreement, and the Event Center is willing and able to continue providing the services; and

WHEREAS, this Board has determined that, in order to ensure continuation of the critical services to the public in response to the ongoing COVID-19 Local Emergency provided for in the Agreement, the granting a waiver of the formal competitive bidding process would serve the best interests of the County pursuant to Ordinance Code 2.83050(e); and

WHEREAS, there has been presented to this Board for its consideration and approval a form of an amendment to the Agreement pursuant to which the total amount authorized to be expended under the Agreement will be increased by \$375,000, from \$500,000 to an amount not to exceed \$875,000 (“Amendment”); and

WHEREAS, this Board has reviewed the Amendment, considered it as to form and substance, and desires to enter into it.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the Director, or the Director’s designee(s), is hereby authorized and directed to execute the Amendment, increasing the maximum amount payable under the Agreement by \$375,000 from \$500,000 to an amount not-to-exceed \$875,000, for and on behalf of the County,

and a waiver of the formal competitive bidding process is granted pursuant to Ordinance Code 2.83.050(e).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director, or the Director's designee(s), is authorized to execute further amendments to the Agreement that modify the County's maximum fiscal obligation up to an additional \$25,000 (in the aggregate), and/or modify the contract term and/or services so long as the modified term and/or services is/are within the current or revised fiscal provisions, including, but not limited to, the modification or addition of any provisions that the Director deems necessary or advisable to comply with Federal Emergency Management Administration (FEMA) reimbursement requirements.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director, or the Director's designee(s), is authorized to apply state and/or federal funds, to include those appropriated by the American Rescue Plan Act, that may be made available for all or a portion of the monies expended on the Agreement and/or the Amendment.

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
