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**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH WEHOPE TO PROVIDE
HOMELESS OUTREACH SERVICES FOR THE TERM OF JULY 1, 2022 THROUGH
JUNE 30, 2024, FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$480,000**

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, in close collaboration with many County and community partners, the Human Services Agency (HSA) coordinates homeless services throughout the County of San Mateo, including homeless outreach services which serve unsheltered individuals and help them connect with shelter, housing and other services; and

WHEREAS, on February 4, 2022, HSA issued a Request for proposals (RFP) to identify providers of homeless outreach program services throughout San Mateo County, and WeHOPE was selected to as the southern region provider based on their experience, qualifications, and overall approach as outlined in the evaluation criteria of the RFP; and

WHEREAS, there has been presented to this Board of Supervisors for its consideration and acceptance an agreement, reference to which is hereby made for further particulars, whereby WeHOPE will provide street-based homeless outreach services in the southern region of San Mateo County for a term of July 1, 2022 to June 30, 2024, for a total obligation amount not to exceed \$480,000; and

WHEREAS, this Board has been presented with a form of said agreement, has examined and approved it as to both form and content and desires to enter into the same.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the President of this Board of Supervisors be and is hereby authorized and directed to execute said agreement for and on behalf of the County of San Mateo, and the Clerk of this Board shall attest the President's signature thereto.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of the Human Services Agency or designee is authorized to execute contract amendments which modify the County's maximum fiscal obligation by no more than \$25,000 (in the aggregate), and/or modify the contract and/or services so long as the modified term or services is/are within the current or revised fiscal provisions.

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
