RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE HIRING OF RETIRED IS PROJECT MANAGER II, BRAD GEORGAKAS, CERTIFYING THE NATURE OF THE EMPLOYMENT AND THAT THE APPOINTMENT IS NECESSARY TO FILL A CRITICALLY-NEEDED POSITION DURING THE POST RETIREMENT 180-DAY SEPARATION PERIOD PURSUANT TO GOVERNMENT CODE SECTION 7522(F)(1).

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, the Assessor's Office is responsible for determining the assessed value of all taxable property located in San Mateo County and Closing the Roll by June 30th of every year; and

WHEREAS, retired IS Project Manager II Brad Georgakas has unique skills,

expertise, and knowledge in the managing and supporting the secured property

information utilized to process the San Mateo County Roll Close; and

WHEREAS, the knowledge and expertise Brad Georgakas is able to provide to the development and timely delivery of the Assessor Property Assessment System (APAS) is essential and unattainable from current County personnel due to his experience in the development, data cleansing and migration, deployment, and enhancement of the legacy assessment system; and

WHEREAS, Government Code §7522.56 requires a One-Hundred Eighty (180) day separation period, as established by the California Public Employees' Pension Reform Act, unless the employer's governing body makes a finding by certifying that the appointment is necessary to fill a critically needed position before the One-Hundred Eighty (180) day separation period has passed; and

WHEREAS, Brad Georgakas' services are needed prior to the expiration of the One-Hundred-Eighty (180) day separation period.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED:

 The President of the Board of Supervisors be and is hereby approves the hiring of retired IS Project Manager II Brad Georgakas to extra help position in order to provide assistance on the development of the Assessor Property Assessment System (APAS) pursuant to Government Code §7522.56(f)(1) and finds that the nature of employment and appointment is necessary to fill a critically-needed position before Mr. Georgakas' post-retirement 180 day separation period expires.
