ACTING AS THE GOVERNING BOARD OF COUNTY SERVICE AREA NO. 8, RESOLUTION:

- A) ADOPTING THE GARBAGE AND RECYCLABLES COLLECTION SERVICE CHARGES REPORT FOR COUNTY SERVICE AREA NO. 8 (NORTH FAIR OAKS) FOR FISCAL YEAR 2022-23; AND**
- B) DIRECTING THE DIRECTOR OF THE OFFICE OF SUSTAINABILITY TO FILE THE GARBAGE AND RECYCLABLES COLLECTION SERVICE CHARGES REPORT FOR COUNTY SERVICE AREA NO. 8 (NORTH FAIR OAKS) FOR FISCAL YEAR 2022-23 WITH THE COUNTY CONTROLLER; AND**
- C) AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF THE OFFICE OF SUSTAINABILITY TO REFUND ANY OVERCHARGES RESULTING FROM DATA, DATA ENTRY, OR COMPUTATION ERRORS; AND**
- D) AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF THE OFFICE OF SUSTAINABILITY TO REVISE THE GARBAGE AND RECYCLABLES COLLECTION SERVICE CHARGES REPORT FOR COUNTY SERVICE AREA NO. 8 (NORTH FAIR OAKS) FOR FISCAL YEAR 2022-23 AS A RESULT OF ANY PARCEL CHANGES RECEIVED FROM THE COUNTY ASSESSOR AND/OR COUNTY CONTROLLER BEFORE JULY 31, 2022, AND TO FILE THE REVISED SERVICE CHARGES REPORT WITH THE COUNTY CONTROLLER**

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, acting as the Governing Board of San Mateo County Service Area No. 8, that

WHEREAS, San Mateo County Ordinance Code Sections 4.04.200 through 4.04.330 require that garbage and recyclables collection service charges in County Service Area No. 8 be collected on the tax roll in accordance with the amounts shown for each parcel of real property receiving such service as shown in a written report filed with the Clerk of the Board; and

WHEREAS, the Director of the Office of Sustainability of the County of San Mateo has prepared the report described in San Mateo County Ordinance Code Sections 4.04.200 through 4.04.330; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing, advertised in local newspaper and pursuant to Government Code Section 54953(e), was a hybrid meeting, open to the public for both in person participation and via Zoom online meeting format as required by Section 4.04.270 of the San Mateo County Ordinance Code and held on July 26, 2022 at 9:15 a.m.; and

WHEREAS, this Board heard and considered all objections or protests to said report at said public hearing and determined that the Garbage and Recyclables Collection Service Charges Report for County Service Area No. 8 (North Fair Oaks) for Fiscal Year 2022-23 should be confirmed and adopted for the 2022-23 fiscal year.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED as follows:

1. This Board of Supervisors does hereby confirm and adopt said report and imposes the service charges set forth therein to be, and the same are hereby, established and set for fiscal year 2022-23.
2. The Director of the Office of Sustainability is hereby directed to certify to the Clerk of this Board that the service charges were calculated in accordance with the garbage and recyclables collection rates adopted by this Board.
3. The Director of the Office of Sustainability is directed to file with the Controller an electronic copy of said report and a statement endorsed thereon that the service charges as set forth in said electronic copy are the charges as adopted by this Board based on the certification of the Director of the Office of Sustainability.
4. The Director of the Office of Sustainability is authorized to refund, as appropriate, any overcharge contained in said report to the owner of the parcel

so overcharged when the overcharge resulted from data, data entry, computation errors as determined by the Director of the Office of Sustainability.

5. The Director of the Office of Sustainability is authorized to revise the Garbage and Recyclables Collection Service Charges Report for County Service Area No. 8 for fiscal year 2022-23 to reflect any parcel changes from the County Assessor and/or County Controller before July 31, 2022. Such revisions shall be certified and filed by the Director of the Office of Sustainability with the Controller's Office consistent with the processes set forth above.
