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RESOLUTION A) ADOPTING PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS, INCLUDING CONFORMANCE WITH PREVAILING WAGE SCALE REQUIREMENTS, FOR THE BROADMOOR SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOL PEDESTRIAN IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT – BROADMOOR AREA; AND

- B) AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS TO CALL FOR SEALED PROPOSALS TO BE RECEIVED BY WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 14, 2022 AT 1:00 P.M. IN THE OFFICE OF THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE/CLERK OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS: AND
- C) AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS TO EXTEND THE CALL FOR BIDS AND BID OPENING UP TO SIXTY (60) CALENDAR DAYS BEYOND THE TIME AND DATE ORIGINALLY SET FORTH BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, on May 18, 2021, this Board adopted Resolution No. 078189, which authorized the Director of Public Works, or designee, to file an application for funding assigned to the Metropolitan Transportation Commission (MTC), committing any necessary matching funds, and stating assurance to complete the Broadmoor Safe Routes to School Pedestrian Improvements Project (Project); and

WHEREAS, 87th Street between Southgate Avenue and Sullivan Avenue, and S. Park Plaza Drive between 87th Street and County limit, are the streets in the Broadmoor area for the proposed roadway surface treatment and pedestrian improvements project; and

WHEREAS, plans and specifications dated July 29, 2022 have been prepared and approved by the Director of Public Works for the Broadmoor Safe Routes to School

Pedestrian Improvements Project in the Broadmoor area, and said plans and specifications have been filed in the office of the Director of Public Works (the "plans and specifications"); and

WHEREAS, the plans and specifications require that the contractors performing the work pay not less than the general prevailing wages, as established by the Department of Industrial Relations, in the locality in which said work is to be performed for each type of workman needed to execute the contract.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED as follows:

- 1. The plans and specifications dated July 29, 2022, for the aforesaid project, which are on file in the office of the Director of Public Works, and to which reference is hereby made for further particulars, are hereby approved and adopted as the plans and specifications to be adhered to in letting and performing the work under a contract for the improvements described therein.
- 2. Said specifications require that the contractors performing the work pay not less than the general prevailing wages, as established by the Department of Industrial Relations, in the locality in which said work is to be performed for each type of workman needed to execute the contract.
- 3. The Department of Public Works is authorized and directed to issue a call for sealed bids and to set the bid opening date and time on Wednesday, September 14, 2022 at 1:00 p.m. in the office of the County Executive/Clerk of the Board of

Supervisors in the Hall of Justice, Redwood City, California. Said bids will be received by the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors and then transmitted to the County Executive's Office in said Hall of Justice and be publicly opened and declared.

- 4. The Director of Public Works is authorized to extend the call for bids and bid opening up to sixty (60) calendar days beyond the time and date originally set forth by the Board of Supervisors.
- 5. The Department of Public Works is further directed to cause the Notice inviting sealed bids to be published for three (3) times in a weekly local newspaper of general circulation, published in the County, and obtain an affidavit of said publication, a copy of which shall be placed on file with the Department of Public Works.

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
