**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF CASH DONATIONS FOR FY 2021-22 IN THE AMOUNT OF \$187,787.00 FROM THE SAN MATEO COUNTY PARKS FOUNDATION AND \$7,920.18 FROM THE JAMES C. BRICE LIVING TRUST**

**RESOLVED**, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

**WHEREAS**, this Board of Supervisors highly values and appreciates financial contributions to the San Mateo County Parks Department (the “Department”); and

**WHEREAS**, the San Mateo County Parks Foundation (“Parks Foundation”) has provided \$187,787.00 in cash donations for the 2021-22 Fiscal Year to help fund projects and programs throughout the San Mateo County park system; and

**WHEREAS**, the \$187,787.00 in cash donations from the Parks Foundation will be used for the following programs, events, and projects: Parks Memorial Bench Program (\$48,168); Bicycle Sunday Program (\$7,500); unrestricted project (\$738); plogging pilot for the Volunteer Program (\$7,000); Parks Rx Program (\$36); San Bruno Mountain general project (\$5,500); oxalis treatment at San Bruno Mountain (\$10,374); repairs at Edgewood trails (\$10,000); Memorial Park ADA picnic areas (\$12,396); Natural Resource Management storage containers (\$5,282); Friendship Park shed (\$3,200); Coyote Point Recreation Area tree health (\$50,000); Quarry Park pump track

(\$4,425); Ohlone Portola heritage trail signs (\$6,682); and Park Ranger Grant Program (\$16,486); and

**WHEREAS**, the James C. Brice Living Trust made a testamentary, unrestricted cash gift to the Department in the amount of \$7,920.18; and

**WHEREAS**, this Board desires to accept the above listed donations and to allocate them as set forth above.

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED** that the Board of Supervisors by adoption of this Resolution hereby authorizes the acceptance of cash donations for FY 2021-22 in the amount of \$187,787.00 from the San Mateo County Parks Foundation and \$7,920.18 from the James C. Brice Living Trust.
