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RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH ADVANCED CHEMICAL TRANSPORT, INC DBA ACTENVIRO TO PROCESS HAZARDOUS WASTE FROM THE COUNTY'S VARIOUS HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE FACILITIES FOR THE TERM OF OCTOBER 4, 2022, THROUGH OCTOBER 3, 2023, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$700,000

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, the Environmental Health Services Division (EHS) operates a

Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) program that collects and safely processes HHW

from residents, small businesses, and municipalities; and

WHEREAS, in March 2021, EHS conducted a Request for Proposals (RFP) to

provide additional labor, equipment, supplies, transportation, and disposal services

related to household hazardous wastes; and

WHEREAS, Clean Harbors Environmental Services, Inc. was selected,

pursuant to the RFP to provide services and its competitive pricing; and

WHEREAS, to ensure continued collection of household hazardous material the HHW program is selecting an additional vendor to assist with providing HHW program services; and WHEREAS, Advanced Chemical Transport, Inc dba ACTenviro (ACTenviro) submitted a bid for the RFP conducted in March 2021 and it now has been selected as the most suitable provider for these services; and

WHEREAS, both parties now wish to enter into an agreement to provide additional labor, equipment, supplies, and to collect, transport, and dispose of waste for the County's HHW program for a term from October 4, 2022 through October 3, 2023 for a total amount not to exceed \$700,000; and

WHEREAS, this Board has been presented with a form of such agreement, has examined and approved it as both form and content, and desires to enter into the agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that

President of the Board of Supervisors be and is hereby authorized and directed to execute an agreement with ACTenviro to process hazardous waste from the County's various household hazardous waste facilities for the term of October 4, 2022 through October 3, 2023, in an amount not to exceed \$700,000, and the Clerk of the Board shall attest the President's signature thereto.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chief of San Mateo County Health or designee is authorized to execute contract amendments, which modify the County's maximum fiscal obligation by no more than \$25,000 (in aggregate) and/or modify the contract term and/or services so long as the modified term or services is/are within the current or revised fiscal provisions.

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
