RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT TO THE SUPPLEMENTAL NUTRITION ASSISTANCE PROGRAM – EDUCATION GRANT FROM THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH, EXTENDING THE TERM THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30, 2023, AND INCREASING THE AMOUNT BY \$533,403 TO AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$2,133,612

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, the County has an interest in advancing the Supplemental Nutrition
Assistance Program – Education (SNAP-Ed) initiative which provides federal funds to
promote healthy eating, physical activity, and access to nutritious foods to reduce the
incidence of chronic disease in low-income communities; and

WHEREAS, the parties entered into an agreement on September 17, 2019, whereby the California Department of Public Health provided funding to support the County's participation in the SNAP-Ed initiative from the period of October 1, 2019 through September 30, 2022, in an amount not to exceed \$1,600,209; and

WHEREAS, the parties now wish to amend the agreement to increase the funding amount by \$533,403 to an amount not to exceed \$2,133,612 and extend the term through September 30, 2023; and

WHEREAS, the Board has been presented with the amendment and has examined and approved it as to both form and content and desires to enter into the amendment.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the President of this Board of Supervisors be and is hereby authorized and directed to execute said amendment for and on behalf of the County of San Mateo, and the Clerk of this Board shall attest the President's signature thereto.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chief of San Mateo County Health or designee is authorized to execute contract amendments which modify the County's maximum fiscal obligation by no more than \$25,000 (in aggregate), and/or modify the contract term and/or services so long as the modified term or services is/are within the current or revised fiscal provisions.
