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RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH THE CENTRAL LABOR COUNCIL PARTNERSHIP TO PROVIDE EMPLOYMENT SUPPORT SERVICES TO FOSTER YOUTH FOR A TOTAL OBLIGATION AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$1,438,395 FOR THE TERM OF NOVEMBER 1, 2022 THROUGH OCTOBER 31, 2025

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, the Human Services Agency's (HSA) Children and Family Services (CFS) branch's mission is to enhance the well-being of children, adults, and families by providing professional, responsive, caring, and supportive services; and

WHEREAS, on June 15, 2022, HSA issued a Request for Proposals (RFP) to identify a provider for employment support services and the Central Labor Council Partnership (CLCP) was selected based on their experience and approach to providing these services as outlined in the RFP criteria; and

WHEREAS, the CLCP is a collaboration of three diverse organizations that includes the Regenerate California Innovation (RCI), ProPath, Inc., and the Central Labor Council (CLC) of Fresno, Madera, Tulare, and Kings Counties; and

WHEREAS, the CLC is the lead agency of the partnership that will hold the agreement with the County; and

WHEREAS, CLCP will provide comprehensive workforce development and employment services to current and former San Mateo County foster youth ages 14 to

25 and will assist youth in identifying and achieving long term career goals that will increase their employability, wages, and promote self-sufficiency; and

WHEREAS, HSA requests the County enter into an agreement with CLCP for the term of November 1, 2022 through October 31, 2025 for a total obligation amount not to exceed \$1,438,395; and

WHEREAS, the Board has been presented with a form of such agreement, has examined and approved it as to both form and content, and desires to enter into same.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the President of this Board of Supervisors be and is hereby authorized and directed to execute said agreement for and on behalf of the County of San Mateo and the Clerk of the Board shall attest the President's signature thereto.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of the Human Services Agency or designee is authorized to execute amendments which modify the County's maximum fiscal obligation by no more than \$25,000 (in the aggregate), and/or modify the agreement and/or services so long as the modified term or services is/are within the current or revised fiscal provisions.

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
