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**RESOLUTION SUPPORTING AN APPLICATION TO THE SAN MATEO COUNTY
TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY FOR THE CYCLE 6 PEDESTRIAN AND BICYCLE
PROGRAM FUNDING FOR PHASE I: SANTA CRUZ AVENUE COMPLETE
STREETS PROJECT**

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, the County of San Mateo Department of Public Works (Sponsor) has identified roadway improvements to the Santa Cruz Avenue and Alameda de las Pulgas Corridor to improve safety for drivers, bicyclists, and pedestrians using the corridor; and

WHEREAS, the Sponsor has developed Phase I: the Santa Cruz Avenue Complete Streets Project (Project) - From Sand Hill Road to 300 feet north of Campo Bello Lane to increase visibility, provide crosswalk improvements, dedicated buffered bicycle lanes, and improve the sidewalks; and

WHEREAS, it is estimated to cost \$ \$2,985,900 to implement the Project scope; and

WHEREAS, the Department is seeking \$2,000,000 for the Project; and

WHEREAS, the San Mateo County Transportation Authority (TA) issued a Call for Projects for the Cycle 6 Measure A & W Pedestrian and Bicycle Program on August

4, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the San Mateo County Transportation Authority (TA) requires the Sponsor's governing board to adopt a resolution:

1. Supporting the Project and application for \$2,000,000 in TA Measure A & W Pedestrian and Bicycle Program funds for Project; and
2. Committing the Sponsor to the completion of the Project, including the commitment of matching funds in the amount of \$985,900 needed for implementation; and
3. Certifying that any funds awarded by the TA will be used to supplement existing funds for program activities and will not replace existing funds or resource; and
4. If funds are awarded, authorizing the Sponsor's Director of Public Works, or designee, to sign a funding agreement or memorandum of understanding (MOU) with the TA for TA Measures A and W Pedestrian and Bicycle Program funding for the Project and to take any other actions necessary to give effect to this resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the Board of Supervisors:

1. Directs the County of San Mateo Public Works Department to submit an application for TA Measure A and W Pedestrian and Bicycle Program funds for \$2,000,000 for Phase I: The Santa Cruz Avenue Complete Streets Project.
2. Authorizes the Public Works Director, or designee, to execute a funding agreement or MOU with the San Mateo County Transportation Authority to encumber TA Measures A and W Pedestrian and Bicycle Program funds.
3. Commits to the completion of the Project, including the commitment of \$985,900 of matching funds needed for implementation, if the requested TA funds are awarded.

4. Certifies that any funds awarded by the San Mateo County Transportation Authority will be used to supplement existing funds for program activities and will not replace existing funds or resources.
5. Authorizes the Director of Public Works, or designee, to take any other actions necessary to give effect to this resolution.

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
