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RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT TO MASTER SALARY
RESOLUTION 079043 TO ADD 13 POSITIONS IN PUBLIC HEALTH POLICY AND
PLANNING

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, section 206a(4) of the San Mateo County Charter authorizes the Board of Supervisors to establish the number of all appointed officers and employees; and

WHEREAS, sections 206a(5) and 508 of the San Mateo County Charter authorize the Board of Supervisors to establish by ordinance or resolution the compensation and benefits of County officers and employees; and

WHEREAS, San Mateo County Ordinance No. 073703 ordered that henceforth the number of County appointed officers and employees and their compensation and benefits shall be established by resolution of the Board of Supervisors.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Board of Supervisors authorizes an amendment to Master Salary Resolution 079043 as follows:

SECTION 1: Part 14 of the Resolution is amended as indicated:

ORGANIZATION 55500 PUBLIC HEALTH, POLICY AND PLANNING

 Item F009S, Patient Care Series is increased by 3 positions for a new total of 15 positions.

- 2. Item F038, Senior Public Health Nurse is increased by 1 position for a new total of 4 positions.
- 3. Item F040, Public Health Nurse is increased by 1 position for a new total of 5 positions.
- 4. Item G243S, Program Coordinator Series is increased by 2 positions for a new total of 3 positions.
- 5. Item F062, Supervising Public Health Microbiologist is increased by 1 position for a new total of 2 positions.
- Item F065S, Public Health Microbiologist Series is increased by 2 positions for a new total of 7 positions.
- Item V260S, IS Support Series is increased by 1 position for a new total of 1 position.
- Item G240S, Case Management/Assessment Specialist Series is increased by 1
 position for a new total of 15 positions.
- Item E420, Medical Office Specialist is increased by 1 position for a new total of 7 positions.
