RE: LOCAL ROAD SAFETY PLAN FOR UNINCORPORATED SAN MATEO COUNTY

Dear Ms. Stillman,

The North Fair Oaks Community Council voted unanimously on November 17, 2022 to support the Local Road Safety Plan for unincorporated San Mateo County. This plan is essential to guiding the implementation of safety improvements for all users of the roads maintained and operated by unincorporated San Mateo County. This includes safety enhancements to pedestrians, bicyclists, and motor vehicles.

The Local Road Safety Plan systematically identifies the roads and intersections that need the most attention. It then recommends proven countermeasures based on collision types most frequently observed on the roadway and intersection. As a result, the plan will provide improvements with the greatest impacts to enhancing safety for the County's communities.

In addition, the Council requests that Public Works conduct a review of traffic incidents and hazards on 2nd Avenue and investigate potential countermeasures. Proposed developments along Edison Way will serve to increase traffic along 2nd, and a proactive approach to dealing with this increased activity seems warranted.
