

THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS COUNTY OF SAN MATEO, STATE OF CALIFORNIA RESOLUTION HONORING AND COMMENDING

City of Millbrae on its 75th Anniversary

WHEREAS, on January 14, 1948, residents of Millbrae traveled to Sacramento to present their new city's charter, and this year the City of Millbrae is celebrating its 75th year of incorporation; and

WHEREAS, in 1948 W.F. Leutenegger was elected mayor to represent Millbrae's nearly 8,000 residents, and Green Hills Elementary School opened as Millbrae's first new school in over 25 years in anticipation of the educational needs of the post-war "baby boom" children; and

WHEREAS, in 1948 Millbrae's chief industries were agriculture, floriculture, dairy and porcelain manufacturing, and many families that built the new city have continued to live in Millbrae; and

WHEREAS, as of 2022 Millbrae is estimated to have over 22,500 residents that are employed in various industries throughout the Bay Area, with children attending one of its four public elementary schools, one middle school and Mills High School.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, hereby congratulates the City of Millbrae on its 75th Anniversary.
