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**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH VIZIENT, INC. TO PROVIDE
GROUP PURCHASING ORGANIZATION PROGRAM FOR THE TERM OF
FEBRUARY 1, 2023 THROUGH JANUARY 31, 2026, WITH TWO ONE-YEAR
EXTENSIONS, AT NO COST TO THE COUNTY OF SAN MATEO**

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, in January 2011, San Mateo Medical Center (SMMC) initiated an agreement with MedAssets Supply Chain Systems, LLC (MedAssets); and

WHEREAS, in February 2016, MedAssets was acquired by Vizient Inc. (Vizient) and is SMMC's current Group Purchasing Organization (GPO); and

WHEREAS, in December 2022, SMMC completed a Request for Proposals (RFP) for a GPO, and of the five proposals sent to vendors, Vizient was the only vendor to enter a submission; and

WHEREAS, SMMC is requesting this Board to waive any formal bid or RFP process for goods and services purchased under this GPO agreement; and

WHEREAS, SMMC is also requesting this Board to authorize the Purchasing Agent to enter into Purchase Orders, Vendor Agreements, Lease Agreements, Rental and Service Agreements for the County of San Mateo for supplies, services and equipment with vendors through Vizient; and

WHEREAS, both parties wish to enter into an agreement for Vizient to provide GPO program for the term of February 1, 2023, through January 31, 2026, with two one-year extensions; and

WHEREAS, this Board has been presented with a form of such agreement, has examined and approved it as both form and content, and desires to enter into it.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the President of the Board of Supervisors be and is hereby authorized and directed to execute said agreement for and on behalf of the County of San Mateo, and the Clerk of the Board shall attest the President's signature thereto.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chief of San Mateo County Health or designee is authorized to execute contract amendments which modify the County's maximum fiscal obligation by no more than \$25,000 (in aggregate) and/or modify the contract term and/or services so long as the modified term or services is/are within the current or revised fiscal provisions.

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
