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RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE HUMAN SERVICES AGENCY DIRECTOR, OR DESIGNEE, TO EXECUTE AN AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT WITH LIFEMOVES TO ADD \$225,000 IN FUNDS, FOR A NEW TOTAL OBLIGATION NOT TO EXCEED \$1,824,250, TO FUND A RAPID RESPONSE OUTREACH DISPATCHER

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, on June 28, 2022, by Resolution No. 079002, this Board entered into an agreement with LifeMoves to provide County-wide street-based outreach and other services with the goal of assisting San Mateo County residents who are unsheltered and experiencing homelessness for the term of July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2024, for a total obligation amount not to exceed \$1,119,250; and

WHEREAS, on December 20, 2022, by Resolution No. 079386, this Board amended its agreement with LifeMoves to add \$480,000 in funds for additional staff capacity to provide after-hours and weekend outreach and engagement services outside of regular business hours, for a revised total obligation of \$1,599,250; and

WHEREAS, the parties now wish to amend the agreement to add \$225,000 in funds, for a new total obligation not to exceed \$1,824,250, to fund one additional outreach case manager who will be responsible for fielding, coordinating, and

dispatching rapid response outreach requests called in by community service providers and first responders; and

WHEREAS, this position will answer calls on a rapid response line during business hours and coordinate to ensure a response occurs within 24 hours, dispatching rapid response requests to the appropriate regional case managers, and in addition, this role will coordinate the timely and accurate collection of rapid response outreach data for reporting purposes;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the President of this Board of Supervisors be and is hereby authorized and directed to execute said amendment for and on behalf of the County of San Mateo, and the Clerk of the board shall attest the President's signature thereto.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of the Human Services Agency or designee is authorized to execute contract amendments which modify the County's maximum fiscal obligation by no more than \$25,000 (in the aggregate), and/or modify the contract term and/or services so long as the modified term or services is/are within the current or revised fiscal provisions.

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
